

**Gilbert Eriksen's 1/30/15 Commentary on Planet X's INFLUENCE upon Saturn & neighboring Planets**

The perturbation of the planets... compliments of the brown dwarf... are consistently happening on the June Solstice side of the ecliptic... and disturbing/perturbing force is coming from the SOUTHERN SIDE of the ecliptic plane. As you can see from the numbers, the Constellation Leo is in the wrong place to accomplish the planetary perturbation that our solar system is suffering from.

The outer planets are the ones experiencing this tugging/perturbing force because they are the ones that have the weakest gravitational grip from the Sun. So they can be perturbed easier. Generally speaking, the closer a planet is to the Sun, the stronger the Sun's "grip" will be on that planet. It was noted back in 2010 that Pluto seemed to be "off track" from where the math predictions indicated that it SHOULD BE. But it WASN'T where it was supposed to be. Look at the Fourmilab diagram below and you can see where Pluto is located orbitally. Sure enough it's out on that side of the solar system... the June Solstice side of the ecliptic.

I mentioned this to some other people and I should share my "guesstimate" with you as well. Note where Saturn is in that same diagram. As it continues its orbital track and as Wormwood gets closer in, I predicted that **Saturn** would also experience some "off track" behaviors. WHY? Because Wormwood will be pulling down on Saturn from the southern side of the ecliptic just like it has been pulling down on the other planets. Only now Wormwood will be closer in and its effects will be stronger. Its effects won't be able to completely disrupt Saturn's orbit because the Sun has the stronger gravitational grip. But Wormwood's progressive approach up underneath the ecliptic will allow for its Jupiter style mass to pull on whatever happens to be within its gravitational "area of influence". That's just how gravity works. And Wormwood has something to say when gravitational pull is under discussion. The closer it gets, the stronger its pull will be. And Saturn is going to be the next planet to feel the tugging effects of Wormwood. At least that is what I would predict for Saturn now.

Note where Saturn will be then... Note also the Earth's position for December 21, 2017... the December Solstice of 2017...

Even if we can't see Wormwood in 2017, Saturn will be feeling its disturbing/perturbing tug from underneath the ecliptic (the Southern side of the ecliptic).

I'm not sure why you seem to have so much trouble trusting the information that the planetary orbits are telling us. The planets have no agenda. The planets don't write books or hold press conferences. The planets don't run for office. But they are VERY OBEDIENT to the laws of celestial mechanics.
