

6. How long do we suffer? That's a difficult question to answer because there are so many parameters to be considered. If we limit the answer, we can come up with some useful numbers. Egypt required 200 years to recover in the sense that the Egyptian monarch fell with the death of the Pharaoh who confronted Moses. Egypt fell, and did not arise until the end of the First Intermediate Period and the beginning of the Middle Kingdom. It was decades, perhaps 60 or 70 years just to drain the flooding caused by the Exodus passage in China.

$\delta^{18}\text{O}(\text{‰})$ Ratio from Greenland Ice Cores



The ^{18}O ratio from the GRIP ice core data (courtesy USGS, Figure 8) offers an estimate of 275-330 years of negative travel after the 2300 BCE Exodus event, 275 years to 440 years based on the recovery period from the Aten asteroid that caused the Bronze Age collapse circa 3100 BCE (destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah) as shown to the left. There is also a deep valley that begins at 6290 BCE and lasts for about 275 years. This valley correlates with a passage of the Destroyer correlated to Noah's Flood, and has the same characteristics as another two or three that I identified as correlated with a Destroyer passage as shown in Appendix 2

These "slides" or "valleys" are correlated with significant drops in atmospheric temperature. So, while the most severe effects of impact winter may dissipate in less than a year, there is documented evidence that the long term effects may last centuries to our detriment, with 275 years the most common estimate.
