

Hi Everybody,

Someone on my BCC list asked me about my claim regarding Moses and Tut in the Blood & Alchemy show I recorded for Dr. Carley's 10/03/2009 broadcast.

To begin with we must understand that to use the Bible as the sole historical reference is like using a phone book as a motorcycle repair manual.

I do comparative analysis using all sources (ancient and contemporary) from all cultures.

The beginning of any of this kind of deconstruction acknowledges the fact that ALL of the Mesopotamian (Greek for: between the two rivers, Tigris/Euphrates) cultures had NO VOWELS in their alphabets. They were implied with the consonants which were the only characters used in writing. You must use European vowel sounds where "a" is "ah" and "e" is "a" and "i" is "e" in normal Midwestern United States dialect of English. So when we break down the actual name of Tut it is *pronounced* Toot Ankh Amoon. That is a far cry from Tutinkamin. The Amoon is often rendered Amen – yes, your evocation of the Egyptian Sun God at the end of every Christian prayer – or Amon because just like Pin Yin Chinese transliterations they either haven't arrived at a standardized spelling that makes sense to a non-propellerhead academic or they were just purposely occulting the meaning. I must emphasize that the Ancient Egyptian Black Magicians said that the ***pronunciation*** of the words were MORE IMPORTANT than the ritual or the artifacts used in the rituals.

I have quite a number of PBS specials on Egypt. (I regret that I am not able to call up the precise episodes at this time). Increasingly over the years, they were featuring the before-mentioned Ahken-Aten (one of the two other names of the Sun God Amen/Amon Ra). Again, this is like an old Three Stooges Episode where Curly would say a normal word in a Joisy Accent and it would be totally funny. Ahken-Aten is a far cry from the common pronunciation of Okenatin.

Dr. Ramses Seleem's translation of the [Egyptian Book of Life](#) page 12 adopts other variations of these spellings such as Atum-Raa where Atum is the 'Beggining, Source and End' and Raa is 'Light'. Emen Raa is 'Hidden Light'. Eten is the 'Sun Disk'. These all have distinct cartouches. To add confusion on chaos he indicates that alternative names for 'God' are Tumu (very close to the male form of Tiamat from Babylonian legend) and Eaau. Where Ea is polarization and Au is expansion. This is just too close to the EA of the Babylonian Trinity that became the YAH after the Semitic/Akkadian invasion for any of this to be coincidence. These 6000 year-old shared name structures are the precursor material found 4100 years ago when Abram migrated from Sumeria to Egypt and then Hey, Presto! [The Book of Life](#) was written around 4000 years ago complete with Judgment Seats and a Lake of Fire that you enjoy in your New Testaments today.

Enter Laurence Gardner [Lost Secrets of the Sacred Ark](#) and you will get a bar of cold steel right in your face of the Family history/secrets/inbreeding and name-changing of the

Dynasty that was built around 'Ahkenaten'. Just go to Gardner's index and follow the trail on the pages indicated but especially page 47 leaving no doubt as to the lineage and strategy that led to it. Gardner follows a scholarly trail through this, while I took a parallel convoluted path rife with speculation and came up with the same conclusion before I read his book.

Egyptologists like the popular Hawass said that Ahken Aten was the Pharaoh who instituted the worship of ONE GOD over the entire pantheon of Egypt. There is a single lineage that promotes ONE GOD going back to Abram who was in Egypt around 4100 years ago. There is a single golden thread that goes through the Bible and that is GOLD. I was aware of that decades before Lawrence Gardner and his theories. I can say categorically that the listeners to Dr. Carley's radio shows work hard to keep themselves informed in vast arenas of knowledge. Feel free to give me your insights on the Gold connection, however, I can neither confirm nor deny Gardner's assertions of the use of monatomic gold. I tried to start a dialog with a professor mentioned in his book on this topic and was met with silence. Whether or not the Pharaohs consumed the Magick Elixir, it is documented that Egyptian mummies were raided, ground to powder and in the very early 1900s were sold by apothecaries as Mummia for human consumption.
